Dear Parent/Guardian:

El Reno Public Schools has received a multi-year grant for a 21st Century Community Learning Center after school program. Grant funds will be used to cover the cost of staff salaries, student supplies and materials, transportation, curriculum, and guest speakers. The grant funds can only be used for Grades 3-6 at this time. As new grant opportunities become available, the district will explore options to expand the *free* after school program to include lower grades.

ERPS students who are current third, fourth, fifth, and sixth graders are welcome to participate in the *free* Project STEAMER after school program. The attached application and parent release must be returned to ***your child's school site office***, before your child can participate in the program. Incomplete applications will be returned for completion, and will delay your child's participation in the program.

Students enrolled in Project STEAMER are expected to follow school rules and procedures. When students are on field trips, in the computer lab, and listening to guest speakers, we expect the students to be on their best behavior as representatives of El Reno Public Schools.

The afterschool program will be housed at **Roblyer Learning Center for Grades 3-6**. Parents must pick up their child from the after school program.
